Instructions:

- 1) Complete the application form fields as indicated and include a copy of the completed application with your essay submission. Be sure to indicate if your submission is a Junior High/Middle School or a Senior High School submission.
 - 2) Submission Requirements and Evaluation
 - a) Submissions must be the original work of the applicant. References to source material should be provided where applicable, preferably using the Canadian Quaker History Journal style guide on the CFHA website (www.cfha.info) or by written request.
 - b) The topic should further the understanding of the experience and contribution of the Quakers in Canada. There is no maximum essay length, but junior high school essays should be at least 1000 words in length, those of senior high school students a minimum of 1500 words. Submission of artistic or creative works on a Quaker theme are welcome in lieu of an essay provided that the subject matter and content provide an historically accurate depiction of an actual Canadian Quaker event, family, or chronicle etc.
 - c) Essays may be typed or handwritten, double spaced and may be submitted as a PDF attachment via e-mail to scholarship@cfha.info or mailed to:
