## Pelham MM Membership, Marriage Register 1817 - 1958

Archives: This Register is held by the Canadian Quaker Archives and Library in Newmarket, Ontario in Box 100 (O-100-1). It has not been microfilmed and is not available on Ancestry.com.

The register is mostly filled with marriages, but some birth and deaths are recorded along with membership lists. The earliest birth recorded is in 1817. However, it appears the register was begun around 1835 with some back entries being made. The last entries are a death in 1958 and a revised membership list in 1957.

This transcription was originally posted on the Canadian Yearly Meeting Archives web site and described as a Pelham Register from 1835 – 1958. By agreement, the register is now posted on the Canadian Friends Historical Association (CFHA) web site. It is made freely available and supports search, cut and paste. CFHA will officially grant linking privileges to organizations that support this free access. The transcription was coordinated by Jane Zavitz Bond, archivist for Canada Yearly Meeting, and fully transcribed by Sheila Havard and formatted for posting by Randy Saylor. CFHA wishes to express its gratitude to those who worked on this project.

The text was transcribed as written, so researchers must consider the many variations in spelling when searching the transcribed text. Minor paragraphing has been done to enhance readability. Transcriber notes are in square brackets. The book has not been proof read.

Orthodox Friends began this minute book after the separation in 1828. The Hicksites kept and continued to use the pre-separation minute book. The last few pages of this book contain a list of the books in the Friends Library and one page of Books Lent.

By the mid 1790's a number of Quakers, mostly from Pennsylvania, had settled in the Niagara area. In 1799, the Philadelphia Yearly Meeting approved the establishment of Preparative meetings at Short Hills in Pelham Township and Black Creek in Bertie Township and one day later Pelham Monthly Meeting was established. The meeting house was rebuilt to be larger in 1807. In 1810 the Canada Half Yearly Meeting was established under New York Yearly Meeting with Pelham, Yonge St and Adolphustown being the Monthly Meetings. Norwich became a Preparative Meeting under Pelham in 1816. Upon the separation in 1828, the Hicksite branch of Pelham came under Genesee Yearly Meeting in 1834.
